

Introduction

Chess club Woensel Lichttoren Combinatie (WLC) was founded at 1 June 1978, after a merger of S.V. Woensel and S.V. Lichttoren. At this moment the club has about 45 senior- and 35 youth members.

WLC wants to enable as many people as possible to enjoy playing chess.

Club evenings

Club evenings are on Tuesday and are usually divided into half an hour of instruction and half an hour of contest. We use the 'Stappen-method' in the instruction. Nine trainers (six certified) give instructions at several levels. Every member receives a workbook with exercises to make at home.

More mature youth members can also participate in the seniors matches, both internal (against other members within the club) and external matches (with a team against other clubs within the region). An adjusted (faster) playing pace applies to internal matches.

WLC participates in various tournaments, such as Eindhoven Cup, Brabant Grand Prix and Personal Championships of the NBSB.

Registration and cancellation of membership

You can sign up preferably by e-mail. At your first instruction the registration form is completed and then a trial period of four weeks starts. After this trial period, the treasurer will ask you to pay the membership fee.

Cancellation of membership must take place before the start of the new season preferably by e-mail.

House Rules

A few rules have been defined to keep order and peace.

General rules

- If you're unable to attend, please inform your trainer or Hub v.d. Laar;
- Be present in time; Not too early, but certainly not too late;
- Take your workbook, eraser and pencil to every instruction;
- Hang your coat neatly on the hooks in the hallway;
- Changing rooms should be calm and quiet. Leave quietly and enter quietly when the door is opened;
- Make homework properly and on time;
- Use furniture for which it is intended;
- Handle all chess materials with care;
- Lost items are delivered to the bar of 'De Hoeksteen';
- Do not run and play tag if you have nothing to do for a moment;

During the Instruction

- All children stay in during the entire instruction;
- When the trainer talks it is quiet;
- Raise your finger if you want to ask a question or say something;
- Do not talk through each other, let each other finish their sentence;
- Do not eat nor drink during the instruction;
- Plan toilet visits before the instruction. Toilet visits during the instruction are only allowed by exception.

During the Contest

- Sportiness is paramount. This means for example:
 - shake hands at the beginning of the game
 - congratulate the winner at the end of a match
 - respect decisions of the referee.
- Be silent during the entire contest, even if your own game has finished;
- The winner puts all pieces into the starting position;
- The one who loses passes the results on to the referee.

Corona Measures

We'll have to follow the Corona rules. These rules will change constantly. As of July 1, the rules are:

- If you or one of your housemates has a cold, short of breath or has a fever, then you must stay at home.
- Parents are only allowed to bring and collect their children at the front door.
- All children keep 1.5m away from the trainer and other adults.
- When you enter, wash your hands with hand gel.
- Also use hand gel after visiting the toilet.

Tournaments

WLC stimulates the visit of tournaments. Especially the Eindhoven Cup and the Christmas tournament of ESV are recommended.

The Eindhoven Cup

This is a tournament to get novice youth players (from Step 1) excited about chess.

Eight times a year there is a sporting meeting on a Sunday morning at one of the organizing clubs and primary schools in the Eindhoven region.

In general, you play against someone of the same level.

The Christmas tournament of ESV

This fun tournament is played between Sinterklaas and Christmas. At this tournament you play against children of the same age. It's hence possible that your opponent has a completely different level.

Santa Claus comes along every year and distributes mandarins. The tournament ends with a prize ceremony and everyone goes home with at least one small prize.

Contribution

The contribution is per season (from September until end of June). For players up to 20 years the contribution is € 50. (reference date for the age is December 31st)
